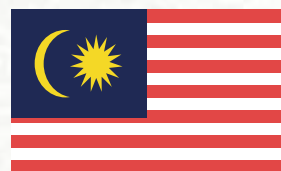

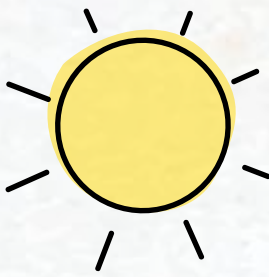


Batasi Mission point: Testimony

One of the greatest works of God in the past 12 months is the establishment of the Senggarang Community Center Building.

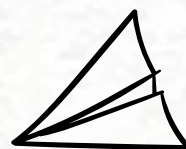
Club and other activities. The community is also allowed to use the building for wedding ceremonies, meetings, and even worship services.

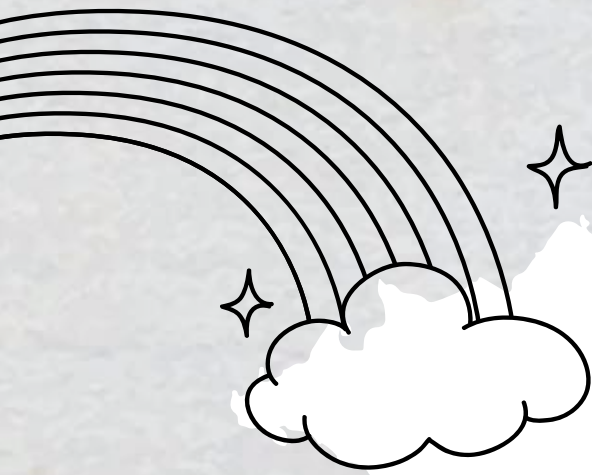

Since the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic in Malaysia in March 2020, **“Rainbow Kids” Children’s Church** has also stopped its physical gatherings due to the pandemic prevention measures. We thought that it was just a short-term suspension of a month, but the MCO was extended time and again.

Besides the children of church members, most of the children in Rainbow Kids are non-believers whom we reached out to via the poverty relief ministry. To uphold the children’s spiritual life, we started the first Facebook live streaming at the end of April 2020. This allowed children to log in to the weekly “Rainbow Kids FB Live” to attend Sunday school. Since September of the same year, we have used ZOOM to step up interaction with children through online fellowship, let them practice worship and pray, and learn the Lord’s Word.

We were also concerned about the needs of children during the pandemic, to the extent of sending supplements to families with covid-positive members when the measures allowed. The children missed the days of being able to attend the Children’s Church on site and could not wait to go back to church.

Thanks and praises be to the Lord, after two years we finally resumed the Children’s Church officially. “Rainbow Kids” resumed physical fellowship on April 17, 2022!

Greetings from Home of Shelter in Myanmar, Yangon.

Thank you for praying for us and encouraging me. God is my everything. God bless you all.

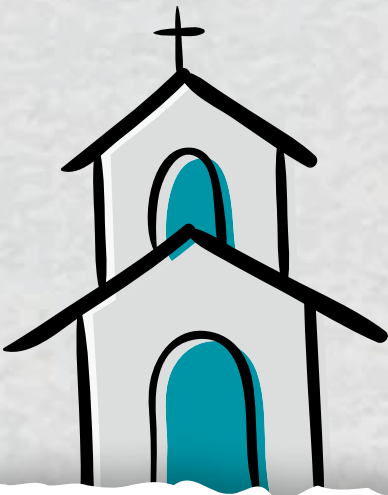

Therefore, we just do prayer ministry for our brethren. What we did was to encourage one another via online, call, chat and text. The new opportunities that God has provided for us in serving the community these days are to offer relief and kneel down before God to pray for the community.

We have grown in our church membership. Presently, our Sunday service attendance exceeds 60 including children. Some were baptized, became leaders and some are serving in the music/worship team. We conduct prayer meetings every Thursday night. We have five

Bible study groups so far within the municipality. We also have members from nearby towns but we are not allowed to go there because of restrictions. Our discipleship training for the young people and children ministry are also ongoing.

Church of Singapore's support has changed many lives and boosted our church attendance. Some were converted, some were baptized and they are now faithfully attending our church activities. God used your support, efforts and lives to touch the hearts of the people and made them aware that God loves them so much. We distributed your food donations from house to house and saw the joy and gladness on the faces of our brethren. The people and their families are full of thanksgiving.

We thank God for the improvement of our ministry. In spite of the pandemic, our ministry is still doing well. We give back all the glory and honour to our living God! Thank you, Church of Singapore! We appreciate you so much and we are always praying for all of you there.

Our gratitude to Church of Singapore who, through the Leadership, has extended relentless help for the sake of the Brethren in our region including some poor and needy families during the pandemic. Some are now attending Church services.

From March 2022, all church ministries are back to work. Now, there are new activities happening in different churches. The School of Ministries (SOM) takes place every Sunday from 1pm to 2pm at Baybay-Pook and from 4pm to 5pm at Cajilo and Makato, and every Wednesday from 6pm to 7pm at the main church at Andagao. Life Groups, Youth Fellowship, Men's ministry, Women's Ministry, Children's Ministry are ongoing at many places. Now, some of them are actively attending the Sunday service. We conducted a special Good Friday service (Lenten days) at Cajilo on April 14 and at Andagao on April 15. 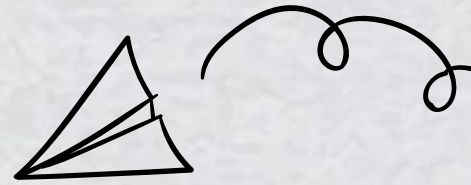

VIETNAM

Govap New Life Church (GNLC) in Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC), Vietnam, continued to grow both in congregational strength as well as members' spirituality in the past two years despite the challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Within the church family, GNLC celebrated three couples getting married and the birth of two babies. A few more couples are also preparing to get married either this year or next year. Two sisters in church, Sami and Ha, have joined GNLC as full-time staff and another sister, Alice, has joined on a part-time basis.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, the church members focused their outreach efforts on

their unsaved family members and friends, as well as the youths in the neighbourhood where GNLC is situated. Pastor Man and his pastoral team would organise regular outreach visits to towns and villages outside of Ho Chi Minh city, some even as far as 400km away, to share the Gospel with the parents of the young adult church members. Through their dedication and perseverance, some of these parents have come to salvation.





My first mission trip to Govap New Life Church was five years ago. Pastor Man brought our Singapore mission team to a university town district out of the city. We visited an international university and did street evangelism with the students. Many of them hail from various parts of Vietnam and speak relatively decent English. They were curious and excited to speak with us. After establishing rapport, we invited them to GNLC for the Good Friday outreach event.

After visiting the university, Pastor Man brought us to a nearby plot of land. He told us that God had given him a vision for a church community space within the university town district where students can come to know Christ in a safe environment. In obedience, he raised funds and purchased the land. We prayed over it that God may bring this church community project to life.

This year, we returned to that plot of land and construction work of the building was well underway. By God's grace and provision, Pastor Man could raise most of the needed funds. Trusting that God will provide the remaining funds, **New Life II (NLII) is scheduled to be completed in mid-October 2022.** There will be many opportunities for the Gospel to be shared with the thousands of students studying in the ten universities surrounding NLII. There will be a café on the ground floor for students to gather in. Regular events will be organised to draw students there. With these activities, events, and the café, NLII hopes to share the Gospel in non-intimidating ways.

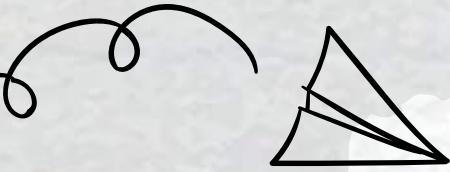


Please pray for Pastor Man, his team, the NLII project and the remainder of its financing. Pray that many Vietnamese university students may have the opportunity to hear the Gospel.

In the last three to four months, **GNLC also started a weekly football ministry on Sunday evenings to reach out to the friends and colleagues of church members through a friendly game of football.** These weekly games have been very effective as a non-intimidating form of Gospel outreach as football is a popular sport in Vietnam. Many of the pre-believers who join the football games politely observe the prayer for safety said by Pastor Man before the opening game each week and also hang around after the games for dinner fellowship and to listen to the Gospel message being shared.

Please uphold Pastor Man and his young full-time pastoral team, the young and vibrant GNLC community, as well as their many outreach activities, in your prayers, so that the light and warmth of our Christian faith may be seen and felt in Ho Chi Minh city.





SOUTH ASIA

I am involved in a vocational school ministry that helps young people get training in auto mechanics and tailoring. As part of the ministry, I will go to a village every Friday to visit the families of the students studying at the school. At the same time, my teammates and I will share God's Word and conduct Sunday School for the children in the village as well.

Each week, we will visit Gopal and Sikandar and their families in this village. They have joined our vocational school since September 2021. **A few weeks after Gopal started his vocational schooling, he met with a serious accident and was in a coma for several weeks. We prayed for him and thanks be to God, he woke up from his coma.** Currently, his left hand still could not

function as normal, and he is not able to walk properly. But thank God for preserving his life and the progressive healing that is taking place. Gopal is diligently doing physiotherapy with his family's help each day. Pray that the exercises will help him to get back to his normal physical condition.

We have given Gopal and his family a New Testament of the Bible. He became a Christian after he came to the vocational school. Since he missed many classes, he must join as a new student in September 2022.

Thank God for his faithfulness. **During the Covid-19 pandemic, God did not abandon the Chinese migrant workers in Singapore.**

During the lockdown, the brothers watched their roommates in their dormitories being taken to hospitals, makeshift hospitals, cruise ships and even hotels. After learning about the situation, we set up a dedicated prayer group immediately to pray with the workers for an hour at noon every day. God empowered them through prayer and commissioned them to face the difficulties.

Church leaders saw the needs of the workers and bought Vitamin C to boost their immunity. In the dormitory for migrant workers in Choa Chu Kang, two evangelistic meetings were held for a hundred people during the Chinese New Year and twenty-four people received the Lord. We prepared their favorite dumplings to help relieve them of their homesickness. To help them understand the local customs

of Singapore, we took them on a tour of the Singapore River. On 1st May 2022 Labour Day, we also took them on a walk in Marina Bay to broaden their understanding of Singapore.

Indeed, mission does not mean having to travel far, and now God has brought the unreached to the doorstep of Singapore. May God

give us the perspective of love to look out for the foreigners around us, and to bring them to God with acts of love.
